



EPICLESIS OF THE HOLY SPIRIT

LITURGY OF ST MARK (CYRIL)

And send down from Your holy height, and from Your prepared mansion, and from Your unbounded bosom, and from the throne of the kingdom of Your glory, the Paraclete— Your Holy Spirit who is an hypostasis, the immutable, the unchangeable, the Lord, the Giver of Life, who spoke in the Law, the Prophets, and the Apostles; who is present in every place, yet not place contains Him; who, on His own authority and not as service, works sanctification on whom He wills, according to Your good pleasure; who is single in His nature and manifold in His working, the fountain of the divine graces; who is of one essence with You; who proceeds from You; the sharer of the throne of the kingdom of Your glory, with Your Only-begotten Son, our Lord, God, Saviour, and King of us all, Jesus Christ—upon us, we Your servants, and upon these Your precious gifts which have been set forth before You, upon this bread and this cup, that they may be sanctified and changed.



Jesus says to Nicodemus: 'The wind (or spirit) blows where it wishes; you hear the sound of it, but you do not know where it comes from, or where it is going' (John 3:8). We know that the wind is there, we hear it in the trees as we lie awake at night, we feel it on our faces as we walk on the hills. But if we try to grasp and hold it in our hands, it is lost. So it is with the Spirit of God. We cannot weigh and measure the Spirit, or keep it in a box under lock and key... Like the air, the Spirit is source of life, 'everywhere present and filling all things', always around us, always within us. Just as the air remains itself invisible to us but acts as the medium through which we see and hear other things, so the Spirit does not reveal to us his own face, but shows us always the face of Christ.

In the Bible the Holy Spirit is also likened to fire. When the Paraclete comes down upon the first Christians on the day of Pentecost, it is in 'cloven tongues, as of fire' (Acts 2:3). Like the wind, fire is elusive: alive, free, ever moving, not to be measured, weighed, or constricted within narrow limits. We feel the heat of the flames, but we cannot enclose and retain them in our hands

God is Spirit (John 4:24)


The Father, the Word and the Holy Spirit, these three are One (1 Jn 5:7)

BLASPHEMY AGAINST THE HOLY SPIRIT

"Therefore I say to you, every sin and blasphemy will be forgiven men, but the blasphemy against the Spirit will not be forgiven men.

Anyone who speaks a word against the Son of Man, it will be forgiven him; but whoever speaks against the Holy Spirit, it will not be forgiven him, either in this age or in the age to come. (Matt 12:31–32)

Old Testament

New Testament

Jesus (Lk 1.35; 3:22; 4:1; 10:21; 24:49), Disciples (Acts 1.8; 2.4; 8.14-17), Phillip (Acts 8.5-8), Paul (19:1-7, Acts 21.4)

In the Sacraments

Called to sanctify the visible gifts set forth (bread, wine, person, oil, water) into invisible gifts that forgives our sins, saves us and leads us into eternal life and renewal

In Us

Received in Baptism, renewed through Repentance, living a life of Humility
